ORDER:

The redeployment of surplus teaching staff in Private Aided Degree Colleges in the State is under consideration of the Government for quite some time. It has come to the notice of the Director of Collegiate Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad through various reports including the reports of the internal Audit of this Department, that certain lecturers working in Private Aided Colleges are being paid their salaries from Grant in Aid even though they are not having sufficient workload due to uneconomic student strength in various groups and subjects for the last three academic years. If these lecturers are continued in the same places without properly and fully utilizing their services to cater to the educational needs of the students, it leads to misuse and wastage of public funds and loss to State exchequer. Also there is a need to shift the students to local/ nearby colleges from those colleges wherever uneconomic strength is noticed and as a consequence, the identified surplus staff are also to be shifted to needy colleges for better and fuller utilization of their services. The shifting is proposed to protect the welfare of the staff to avoid the stoppage of Grant in Aid to such posts and to avert retrenchment of staff, who otherwise will have to be terminated on account of uneconomic strength continuously for three or more years. On the other side, due to administrative and other reasons, number of lecturer posts are vacant in Govt./ Private Aided Degree Colleges in the State.

The Govt. prescribed the minimum economic strength to Private Aided Rural/Urban Colleges vide the reference second read above. Based on the audit reports of the Department regarding the students strength and workload position, the teaching staff requirement was reviewed with the Correspondents/ Principals of Private Aided Colleges in the months of August and Sept. 2005 and surplus lecturers were identified.

Subsequently, through the correspondence vide the references third to sixth read above, the Govt. have provided guidelines and accorded permission for the redeployment of the surplus teaching staff of Aided Colleges, exempting from the condition at para 3 (b) of G.O. Rt. No.890 Edn., Education (CE.II) Department, dated 02.08.1996 and to shift the surplus teaching staff to needy colleges having sanctioned posts and requisite workload.

Keeping in view the uneconomic strength in certain courses/sections/groups, as the case may be, and consequent on decrease in the workload in the subject concerned due to decrease in the student enrolment, certain lecturers working in the department/subject of Private Aided Colleges were found surplus. The identified surplus staff of Private Aided Colleges are now redeployed to needy Govt./ Pvt. Aided Colleges to work as 'On Duty Basis' temporarily.

In view of the circumstances explained above, the Director of Collegiate Education has decided to redeploy the following surplus lecturer of Private Aided College to needy Govt./ Private Aided College as detailed below:-

**Dr.M.Nirmala Kumari** Reader/Lecturer in **Public Administration, Sri Padmavathi Mahila Kalasala, Saidabad, Hyderabad** whose post is declared as surplus due to decrease in student strength/ lack of workload is temporarily redeployed as "*On Duty Basis*" to **Government Degree College, Vidyanagar, Hyderabad**

The Correspondents of the Aided Colleges concerned are requested to relieve the redeployed lecturers on the last instruction day of the academic year 2005-06 or thereafter, but before 25<sup>th</sup> March 2006 to enable them to join duty immediately in the college to which they are redeployed. The redeployed lecturer is informed to report at the new place allotted as hitherto immediately after his relief from the present college. They are not eligible for any TTA/joining time etc., as these orders are issued on their redeployment.

- ii. If the Management do not relieve the lecturer who is now under orders of redeployment, the GIA for that post shall be withheld from 26.03.2006 onwards and the Management has to pay the incumbent from their own finances.
- iii. The surplus lecturer identified and re-deployed as above, shall be brought back to their parent College, if there is increase in the students strength and workload in the subject and needed in the subsequent years, on receipt of a report from the parent college and after a review by the Department.
- iv. The surplus staff now redeployed will continue to draw their salaries from the grants released to their parent institutions. The Correspondents are requested to draw their salaries from the provision of GIA already sanctioned to their parent institution without any delay based on the *attendance certificate* of the preceding month received from the Principals of Government/ Private Aided Degree Colleges concerned where they are now drafted to work as "On Duty Basis".
- v. The Principal/ Correspondent of Government/ Private Aided College is informed to send the Attendance Certificate to the parent institution to which the redeployed lecturer originally belongs, every month for drawl of his/her salary from the provision of Grant-in-Aid.
- vi. The dates of relief and joining duty of the redeployed lecturers shall be reported to the Director of Collegiate Education / Regional Joint Director of Collegiate Education / Principals of the identified Govt. Colleges of the districts promptly.

## AGREEMENT OF CONTRACT FOR SERVICE

An agreement made on 3rd day of Sept. 2016 between College Planning and Development Council of Vivekananda Government Degree College Vidyanagar, Hyderabad, represented by President (First Part) and Smt/Sri. Dr. I. K. Padma, H.No. \_\_\_\_\_ (Second Part).

**NOW, THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the party to the second part agrees to perform the teaching work in accordance with the curriculum of the University for the Course from 01.06.2016 to 31.03.2017.

2. That the party to the second part shall carry out further instructions given to him by the College Planning and Development Council from time to time in the discharge of his/her duties as a teacher, mentioned in part 1 above.
3. That the party to the second part agrees after being informed that he/she is fully aware of the fact that his/her service is being taken not to fill any vacancy either or temporary or permanent basis, that he/she will be paid a consolidated amount per month during the Contract Period that his/her contract shall automatically comes to an end on expiry of the said period or on report of a regular lecturers to duty in that subject whichever is earlier.
4. That the contract is terminable by the party of the first part i.e. College Planning and Development Council at any time during the said period and the party of the second part in such case is not entitled to question the correctness of the decision of the College Planning and Development Council.
5. That the part of the second part is not entitled for any other perks, allowances or any other facility except for the consolidated amount payable monthly mentioned in condition 3<sup>rd</sup> above.
6. That if the party of the second part is not willing to continue as Contract Faculty, he/she should give a prior notice of the one month to the party of the first part.
7. That the work performance of the party of the second part will be judged by the Head of the Department of the concerned subject/faculty as well as the Principal of the college.

- a) That the party of the second part is not entitled to renewal or extension or continuation of the contract on any ground unless he/she has fulfilled performance benchmarks, he/she puts up 90 % of attendance and puts up documentary evidence of having conducted slip-tests/ remedial classes in the academic year 2015-16 and achieved not less than 40% pass percentage in the subjects taught by him/her in the academic year 2015-2016.
- b) That the party of the second part agrees to undertake additional hours of remedial classes for the students and undergo faculty training whenever required to do so by the competent authorities.
- c) That the party of the second part is liable to be transferred to any institution due to exigencies of work at Government Degree Colleges in the State of Telangana or due to the performance of the individual.
- d) That he/she is not entitled to any renewal or extension or continuation of the contract on any ground whatsoever.
- e) That the service rendered during the contract will not be construed reckoned as part of any regular appointment for any post in the Government and therefore no credit or weightage will be given for the service rendered in the contract period.
- f) That the party of the second part is liable to be supportive of extra curricular activities/State Govt flagship programmes such as Swachch Bharat, Telangana Harita Haram (THH) etc., as required by the Principal.
- g) **Terms of Contract agreement:** All persons appointed on contract basis should execute an agreement in this format on a Non-Judicial Stamp paper of Rs 100/- with two witness and furnish the same to the Head of the institution concerned at the time of reporting for the duties, agreeing to the terms and conditions of the contract.
