Outcome	The activities conducted have inculcated scientific temper in the students and has further motivated them to participate in many such events.





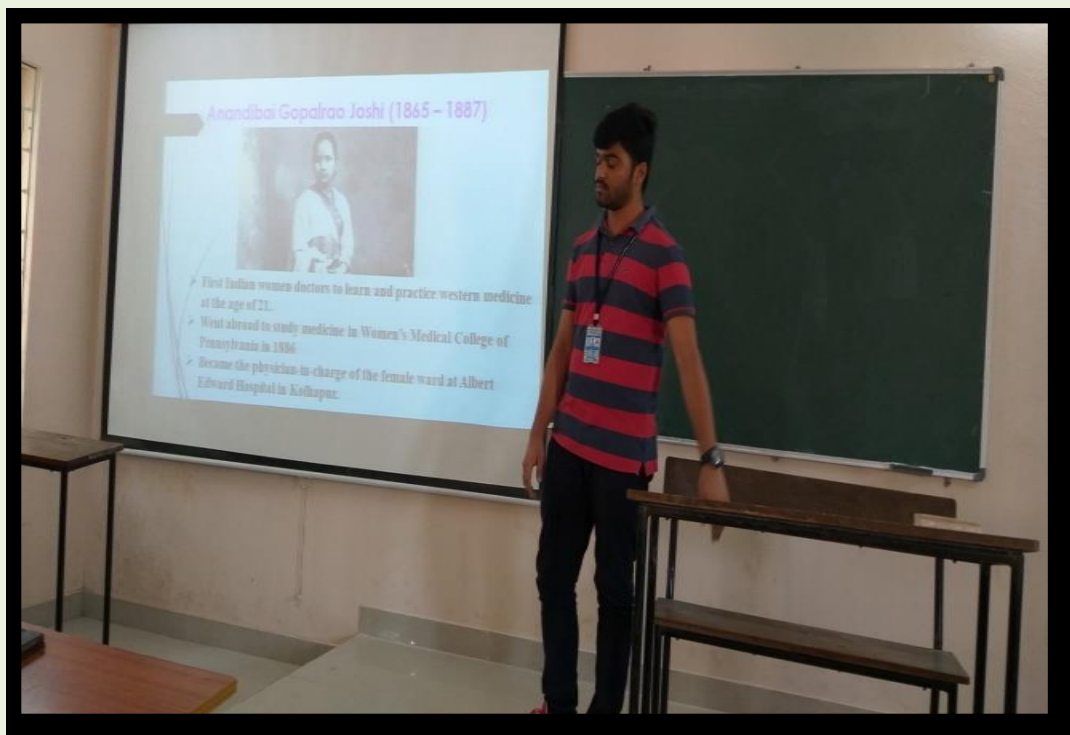
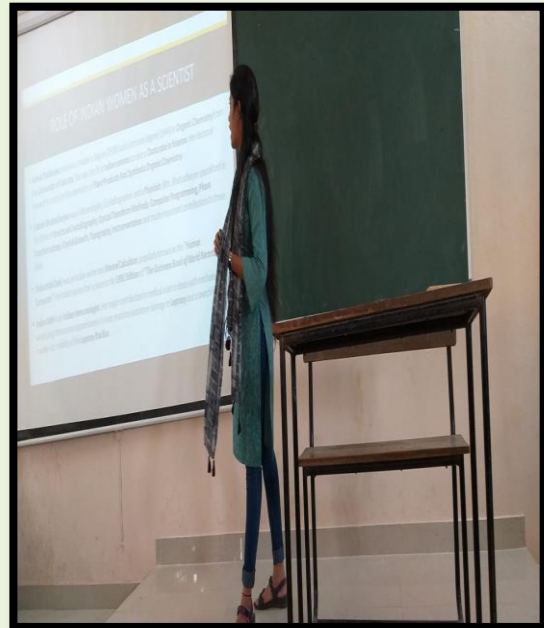




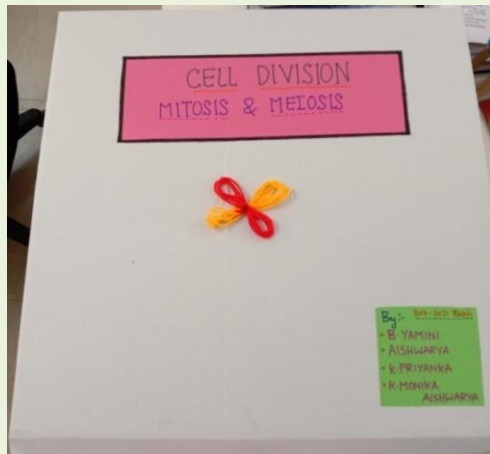
