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



This Individual Consultant Contract (hereinafter referred to as the 'AGREEMENT' is made at Hyderabad, India, this day of Wednesday, 24th September 2019.

BETWEEN

Prajwala, a pioneering anti-trafficking organisation in India dealing with prevention, rehabilitation, rescue and reintegration of victims of sexual crimes located at Survey No 64/2, 65/3, Basavaguda Road, Mankhal Village, Maheshwaram, Rangareddy - 501359.

AND

Ms. Anita Abraham, Associate Professor, VGDC, Vidyanagar, Hyderabad, residing at House No. 37-93/123, Road No. 04, Madhura Nagar, Neredmet, Hyderabad, Telangana - 500056.

WHEREAS the Consultant is professionally qualified person in the field of personality development and management, Capacity building, Leadership training, etc.

AND WHEREAS Prajwala is an anti-trafficking organisation working on the issue of sex trafficking and sex crime, with pan India and international operations.

AND WHEREAS Prajwala has planned to organize 04-day staff capacity building workshops for shelter team on team building, teamwork, leadership, counselling skills, etc for a project supported by SNF.

AND WHEREAS Consultant has agreed to enter into this AGREEMENT and proposes to work with Prajwala in coordinating, planning, and organising capacity building workshops for shelter team (04 days) (Hereinafter referred to as the "ASSIGNMENT").

Terms and Conditions of the agreement:

1. This AGREEMENT will be valid for a maximum period of 01 year, from 24th September 2019. It may be renewed by mutual consent of both Parties, depending on the fulfilment of objectives of this AGREEMENT.
2. Purpose of the agreement is planning and organising the capacity building training workshops for shelters team those who are directly dealing with victims of sex trafficking and sex crime.





Led by Ruberoo in Hyderabad, Samvidhan LIVE! The Jagrik Project is a campaign aimed at building young people's capacities in learning about the Indian constitution experientially. A 2-month campaign with more than 60 young people in Hyderabad, the participants led tasks based on the Fundamental Rights and Duties. The campaign is led by ComMutiny - The Youth Collective, Delhi and regionally more than 26 organizations across India are a part of this public initiative.


Rubaroo's Samvidhan Live!

This campaign aims to engage 50 young Jagriks (Jagruk + Nagrik or awarecitizens) in Hyderabad between the age of 18 to 25 years from diverse socio-economic backgrounds to understand and gain hands on experience of the Indian constitution and the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
